### ***NCHA to host 'Cuttin' Out Hunger' food drive July 16***

(Fort Worth, TX)- The National Cutting Horse Association will be hosting a food drive at the NCHA office July 16, from noon to 8 pm. The 'Cuttin' Out Hunger' food drive will benefit the Tarrant Area Food Bank and will be held in conjunction with NCHA's Summer Cutting Spectacular presented by Great American Insurance.

NCHA will be filling a horse trailer at the "drive-thru food drive". Staff will be on-site during the food drive to make donating as easy as possible. Donors need not even leave the vehicle – just pull up, and let one of the NCHA staff unload your donation into the horse trailer. The NCHA office is located at 260 Bailey Ave, Fort Worth, Texas 76107.

Contributors receive complimentary Summer Cutting Spectacular tickets, so you can go around the corner from the office to Will Rogers Coliseum to watch some of the top cutting horses in the nation compete for an estimated \$2 million. The Summer Cutting Spectacular takes place July 11 – 31 with classes beginning at 8 a.m. daily.

According to the Tarrant Area Food Bank Web site, they aim to eliminate hunger in Fort Worth and 13 neighboring counties through food donations, educational outreach and other resources. TAFB serves a multitude of people from senior citizens on fixed incomes to the severely disabled, in addition to working with several hunger-relief charities.
