\$200,000 LIMITED NON-PRO CONTEST

(Will be a Separate Contest)



1. The Non-Professional class limitation is based on Non-Professional earnings up to Dec. 1, 1995 plus all money won in all approved classes after that date whose lifetime earnings in NCHA-approved and/or sponsored events equal less than \$200,000 as of January 1, 2011 and is restricted to current NCHA Non-Professional card holders.

2. Nomination fees for Limited Non-Pro Contest:

On or before September 1, 2011 \$500

On or before October 1, 2011.....\$955*

Total.....\$1,455

There will be a 10-day grace period. (Official postmark by US Postal Service)

Late entries or payments postmarked after the ten (10) day grace period will be

subject to a penalty of 50% of the payment (Total \$2,155). Late entries will be

accepted after the draw but before the beginning of the first go-round by pay-

ing five (5) times the nomination fee, a total of \$7,055. *There is a \$25 cattle sur-

charge & \$10 drug fee per entry. added to the final payment. *Includes a \$20 PAC

fee (Under Texas Election Code, Chapter 253, the Political Action Committee

(PAC) fee is a voluntary contribution. Funding the PAC is important to be able to

maintain state funding at the NCHA Triple Crown. Your contribution will provide

critical assistance to the NCHA with this effort. To opt out of the PAC fee, sub-

mit your payment without the amount indicated as the PAC fee for your class). Checks from a C or S Corporation can not be accepted by the PAC.

3. The \$200,000 Limited Non-Pro contest will consist of one go-round and a 75 horse semi-finals with the high scoring twenty percent (20%) from the first go round with a maximum of thirty (30), will advance to the finals (max 5 sets) regardless of the number of horses for the semi-finals and (max 2 sets) for the finals. There will be no premium payments made to any entrants who do not qualify in the limited classes.

a. In the event there are less than twenty-five (25) entries in a class, as of October 1, 2011, there will not be a working finals. Payout will be made according to the NCHA mandatory payout.

b. All finalists will receive premium checks.

4. Riders may ride two (2) horses of any sex in the Limited Non-Pro Contest.

5. If a rider has attempted to compete in these classes and is found to be ineligible, disciplinary action may be taken. The burden of proof of eligibility is upon the rider.

6. All rules of the 2011 NCHA World Championship Futurity will apply in this event where applicable.

7. The class is a stand-alone class with go-rounds held in the Watt Arena.

8. Blood and/or urine samples will be taken from Champions and Reserve Champion in all divisions, plus random samples throughout the show.
