

2011 Borden Milk/NCHA World Championship Futurity AMATEUR CUTTING HORSE CONTEST



1. The 2011 NCHA World Championship Futurity Amateur Cutting Horse Contest will be limited to NCHA Non-Professional and Amateur card holders whose lifetime earnings in NCHA approved LAE Non-Professional and Amateur Contests equal less than \$50,000 as of January 1, 2011 and total lifetime earnings less than \$100,000.
 - a. No person may compete in this class who has ridden, trained or assisted in training horses or horse riders, on horseback, for remuneration, directly or indirectly, nor may such a person's spouse, ex-spouse, relative of either living in the same household, or minor children. Any person who receives pay to work in any manner on the premises of a horse training operation shall also be ineligible as well as any person who has been granted apprentice trainer status. In addition, any person who has had or is currently involved in a spousal relationship with a horse trainer is ineligible for Amateur status in this Association.
2. The 2011 NCHA World Championship Futurity Amateur Cutting Horse Contest will consist of one go-round and a 75-horse Semi-Finals with 30 horses advancing to the finals. All finalists and semi-finalists will receive premium checks.
 - a. **A maximum of 5 sets regardless of the number of horses for the semi-finals and a maximum of 2 sets for finals.**

- Of these amounts, \$750 will be jackpotted and \$500 will be retained to cover costs of cattle and facilities. *There is a \$25 per entry cattle surcharge and a \$10 drug fee per entry added to the final payment. *Includes a \$20 PAC fee (Under Texas Election Code, Chapter 253, the Political Action Committee (PAC) fee is a voluntary contribution. Funding the PAC is important to be able to maintain state funding at the NCHA Triple Crown. Your contribution will provide critical assistance to the NCHA with this effort. To opt out of the PAC fee, submit your payment without the amount indicated as the PAC fee for your class). Checks from a C or S Corporation can not be accepted by the PAC.
5. Late entries or payments postmarked after the ten (10) day grace period will be subject to a penalty of 50% of the payment (Total \$1,930). Late entries will be accepted after the draw, but before the beginning of the first go-round by paying five (5) times the nomination fee, a total of \$6,305.
 6. All rules of the 2011 NCHA World Championship Futurity will apply in this event where applicable.
 7. **Blood and/or urine samples will be taken from Champions and Reserve Champion in all divisions, plus random samples throughout the show.**
