2011 Super Stakes Stallion Subscription Program Rules

1. ELIGIBILITY:

- a. Stallions
 1. Stallions must be subscribed by Dec.31, 2011 for the 2013 foals to be eligible to compete in the 2012 Super Stakes.
 2. **Horses by Stallions that have been subscribed by Dec. 31, 2011 will automatically be eligible to enter the 2012 NCHA Super Stakes/ Super Stakes Classic.**
- b. Foals
 1. All foals born in 2011 and beyond must be nominated by Dec. 31 of their weaning year (12/31/11) to be eligible to compete without penalty in the NCHA Super Stakes.
 2. Nominated foals are also eligible to compete as 5 & 6 year olds.

2. COST PER STALLION:

- a. \$2,500 plus \$100 stallion subscription insurance fee (\$2,600 total).
- b. Due December 31 of each year prior to the following breeding season.
- c. 10% penalty from January 1 through January 31 (\$2,750 plus \$100 insurance).
- d. Fees collected will be used for Super Stakes added money for the show associated with the breeding crop's 4-year-old year.
- e. In the event that a stallion is advertised as subscribing, but does not pay by January 31 of the breeding season year, the stallion subscription insurance program will issue a check for \$2,750 for the subscription and the stallion owner will be billed \$5,000.
 1. If the \$5,000 is not paid with 15 days of the billing date, the stallion owner will be suspended until the amount is paid.
 2. When the \$5,000 is paid, the entire amount will be credited to the stallion subscription insurance program account.

3. COST PER FOAL:

- a. The stallion of the foal must be nominated for the foal to be nominated.
- b. Due December 31 of each year as follows:
 1. Weaning year = \$200 .
 2. Yearling year = \$2,500.
 3. 2-year-old = \$7,500.
 4. 3-year-old and older = \$10,000.
- c. Fees collected will be used for Super Stakes added money for the show associated with the breeding crop's 4-year-old year.

4. USE OF FUNDS:

- a. The minimum amount contributed to the added money of the Super Stakes from the program will be \$500,000 per year during the transition. Those funds will be borrowed by the subscription program, with a 4% interest charge assessed for the NCHA administration.
- b. After all borrowed funds have been repaid, the amount contributed to the added money for the Super Stakes from the program will be the amount of fees actually generated from the program, including the 10% penalty for stallion fees made during January of each year.

5. SPLIT OF ADDED MONEY:

- a. As long as the added money contributed to the Super Stakes from the program does not exceed \$600,000, the split will continue to be \$50,000 to the Super Stakes Classic and the remainder to the Super Stakes.
- b. Once the added money contributed to the Super Stakes from the program exceeds \$600,000, the split will be 10% of the added money contributed to the Super Stakes Classic and the remainder to the Super Stakes.
- c. The split of added money between classes in each show will follow current NCHA guidelines.

6. SIRE AWARDS (4-Year-Olds Only):

- a. As long as the added money contributed to the Super Stakes from the program does not exceed \$600,000, the Sire Award will continue to function by current guidelines.
 1. 5% of the Stallion Subscription deducted for the award.
 2. Award to be prorated between Open and NonPro Champion.
 3. Award paid 50% to stallion owner and 50% to stallion nominator.
- b. Once the added money contributed to the Super Stakes from the program exceeds \$600,000, the following Sire Awards program will be implemented:
 1. 15% of the Stallion Subscription deducted for the award.
 2. Award split between stallion nominator and foal nominator:
 - a. 60% to stallion nominator.
 - b. 40% to foal nominator.
 3. Award split between Open, NonPro and Amateur classes:
 - a. 50% to the Open.
 - b. 35% to the NonPro.
 - c. 15% to the Amateur.
 4. Award will be paid to multiple places:
 - a. Top 20 plus ties in the Open:
 1. Top half based on units system after deducting bottom half.
 2. Bottom Half:
 - a. \$600 to each stallion nominator.
 - b. \$400 to each foal nominator.
 - b. Top 20 plus ties in the NonPro:
 1. Top half based on units system after deducting bottom half.
 2. Bottom Half:
 - a. \$300 to each stallion nominator.
 - b. \$200 to each foal nominator.
 - c. Top 10 plus ties in the Amateur, based on units system.
