This contest is open to all NYCHA members; you do not have to attend the Summer Cutting Spectacular or the Youth Convention to participate in the contest. Great prizes will be awarded including one \$500 scholarship for the best overall essay. You can even earn LEAP points by submitting an entry!

Age Divisions – All divisions can get help with typing, but must write and edit the essay themselves.

- 9-12
- 13-15
- 16 & up

Guidelines

- Essays should be 1,000 words or less.
- Essays will be judged on spelling, punctuation, and content.
- Essays must be typed.
- Each essay should have a cover sheet stating the contestant's name, address, phone number and member number; the title of their essay; and the age division in which they will be competing.
- All entries are the property of NYCHA and will not be returned.
- Winning essays may be used for promotional purposes.

Topic for all age groups:

Discuss an experience in cutting that has taught you a lesson and helped improve your sportsmanship.
