1. Call to Order & Roll Call
2. NEW Super Stakes Sire & Foal Nomination Program: Penalty for Foal Nominations
3. Add a Consolation go-round at Futurity – similar to Wild Card. The go-round will be limited to 120 horses plus ties (selected from the highest advancing, based on trials score that do not make Semi Finals). Pay an \$850 entry fee. One go-round, top five places advance to Semi-Finals and work last in a set of cattle. Horses that advance do not receive Semi-Finals money, only a chance to advance to the Futurity Finals.
4. Limited Non Pro
  - a. Change back to Class Within Class (in the Non Pro) – option of entering Non Pro, Limited Non Pro or BOTH
  - b. Combine Limited Non Pro and Amateur – option of entering Limited Non Pro, Amateur or BOTH
  - c. Eliminate Limited Non Pro and raise Amateur limit
5. Review payout of Limited Age Events – with sliding scale based on number of entries
6. Discussion on allowing 16-horse sets at the Super Stakes and Summer Show in the first go rounds
7. Discuss the importance of attending awards presentations.
8. Discussion of Awards Presentations on the arena floor
9. Establish a Medication Advisory Board with regard to drug testing with NCHA being in charge of protocol.
10. Discuss Weekend Limited Aged Events that have \$750 added in a class be required to furnish 3 head of fresh cattle per entry and shows with less added money per class would not have furnish 3 head.
11. Publish Standing Committee Chairman and Vice Chairman's name with phone numbers on the Standing Committee page listed in monthly Chatter and furnish information on NCHA website for members benefit.
12. Discussion of regional representation on the LAE Committee – Need Region 4
