

Sixth Box Testing for NCHA Judge Cards For \$100,000+ Winners

(Checklist as of January 1, 2016)

1. All applicants must be over 19 years old, must be an active member and must have been a member for at least five (5) years. _____

2. The applicant shall not have a record of suspension or probation for the three (3) year period preceding the application. Any person seeking approval must have been an active competitor for the past three (3) years and must have won a lifetime minimum of \$100,000. _____

3. Each application must be endorsed by one (1) current Director in the applicant's area. _____

4. A non-refundable fee of \$125 must accompany all applications. Upon receipt of the application the applicant will be mailed an open book written test to be completed and mailed back to NCHA. _____

5. After passing the test with a minimum score of 80% and after all endorsements are received, the applicant will be tested through live judging pending the approval of the Director of Judges and the Judges Rules Committee. _____

6. After all requirements are met call the NCHA Office at least two weeks in advance to schedule a time to be tested during the Futurity, Super Stakes or Summer Show. _____

7. All applicants must send in a signed copy of the NCHA Judge's Code of Ethics before they can be approved. _____

8. All applicants must provide a head and shoulders picture of themselves in judging attire before they can be officially approved to judge. _____

APPLICANTS WILL NOT BE SCHEDULED TO TEST OUT OF THE SIXTH BOX UNTIL ALL OF THESE REQUIREMENTS ARE MET.

You will be tested on three sets of works. The applicants must score 75% or higher on all three sets to become an approved judge.
