

2011 Ft Klamath Ranch Festival Futurity & Aged Event Rules

Ft Klamath, Oregon, August 20-27, 2011

1. **Verification of Ownership.** Proof in the form of a photocopy of the registration certificate or a notarized statement of age and description, along with a notarized bill of sale must be submitted with all entries. Futurity horses shall not have been shown previously except in aged events.

2. **Aged Event classes to be held:**

Within each of the open, non pro and amateur classes will be a Gelding division. Within each of the non pro classes will be held a 100,000 Limit.

3. **Class Limits.** The number of entries will be limited in each division as follows.

Open Futurity- 175	Open Derby - 100	Open Classic/Challenge -85
Non Pro Futurity- 60	Non Pro Derby - 60	Non Pro Classic/Challenge - 85
	Amateur Derby - 50	Amateur Classic/Challenge - 60

Entries for the Gelding and \$100,000 Limit division within the above classes will remain open until the beginning of each applicable class.

4. **Entries:** All entries are due and payable in full by August 1, 2011. All entries not postmarked by August 9, 2011 will be assessed a \$150 late fee. NO EXCEPTIONS! Entries may be transferred between divisions only if approved by Show Management and depending upon availability. Entries will not be accepted without full payment. Entries for the gelding, 100,000 Ltd, derby open 10K Ltd horse and derby non pro 10K Ltd horse divisions will remain open until the beginning of the each respective class.

5. **Fees:** Total entry fees will be as follows: Futurity Open - \$1520, Futurity Non Pro - \$1170, Derby Open & Non Pro - \$1320, Classic/Challenge Open & Non Pro - \$1320, Derby & Classic/Challenge Amateurs - \$620 (If already entered in the non pro divisions - \$400), Derby Open & Non Pro 10,000 Ltd Horse - \$300. Gelding & 100,000 Ltd - \$150. Futurity Open Gelding - \$300.

6. **Go Round Advancement:**

- a. **Futurity Open:** 100% of all horses competing in the first go shall advance to the 2nd go. 25% with a maximum of 30 horses advance to the finals. All Finalists receive a check.
- b. **Futurity Non Pro:** 100% of all horses competing in the first go shall advance to the 2nd go. 25% advance to the finals, maximum of 25 and a minimum of 6.
- c. **Derby and Classic/Challenge Open & Non Pro:** 70% of all horses that competed in the first go round shall advance to the 2nd round. 25% advance to the finals with a maximum of 25 and a minimum of 6.
- d. **Derby Amateur, Classic/Challenge Amateur:** One go round with 30% of all horses that competed in the first go round shall advance to the finals with a maximum of 25 and a minimum of 6.
- e. **An advancement fee** of \$150 will be charged to all horses advancing to the finals.
- f. **Calculations on percentage used for advancement** are to the nearest whole number. (i.e. 10.4 will advance 10 horses, 10.5 will advance 11 horses.)

7. **Payouts:**

- a. **Futurity Open and Non Pro:** 2.5% of jackpot purse shall be paid in each go round. Go round money to be paid to one per ten entries with a maximum of 4. The Futurity Finals Purse shall consist of the balance of the jackpot purse plus all added money.
- b. **Derby & Classic/Challenge Open & Non Pro:** No go round money will be paid. The total purse plus 100% of the added money will be paid in the finals.
- c. **Derby & Classic/Challenge Amateurs:** No go round money will be paid. The total purse plus 100% of the added money will be paid in the finals.
- d. **Derby Open & Non Pro \$10,000 Ltd Horse:** No go round money will be paid. The total purse will be paid in the finals. Payout is to 25% of the furthest advancing horses in each division.
- e. **Gelding & 100,000 Ltd:** No go round money will be paid. The total purse will be paid in the finals. Payout is to 25% of the furthest advancing horses in each division.

8. **Draw.** Futurity draw will to be made Wednesday, August 17, 6pm.

9. **Judging.** *A five judge AMS system will be used.*
10. **Stall fees.** Stall fees will be \$150 due and payable on August 1, 2011. Any stall reservations not postmarked on or before August 9 will be \$165. No stall refunds will be given.
11. **Refunds.** Show management will consider refunding fees prior to the draw for only two reasons: 1) a sick or injured horse with a veterinarian's verification; 2) a sick or injured rider, with physician's verification. Absolutely no refunds for any other reason. An office charge of \$150 will be retained. However, if there is a cancellation of the show, all fees paid to that time will be returned.
12. **NSF Checks.** Individuals presenting NSF checks, which cannot be redeemed for the full amount in cash, are subject to appropriate legal proceedings and prosecution as well as expulsion from participating cutting horse associations. Checks that are returned from the bank will be charged a \$50 fee.
13. **Ties.** If there are any ties for the Championship of any class Co-Champions shall be declared. First and second place moneys will be divided equally. There will be a work off or coin toss for the awards. Three way or greater ties shall be worked off with one being determined as Champion and remainder as Co-Reserve Champions. The Champion will receive the Champion purse with the Co-Reserve Champions splitting the purse equally.
14. **Disputes.** Show Management will deal with all disputes and their decisions will be final. Show Management reserves the right to disqualify any contestant for actions of misconduct. Any contestant disqualified will lose their right to entry fees, purse moneys and stall fees.
15. **Changes.** Show management reserves the right to make any changes, additions and deletions to these rules as deemed necessary by them for the betterment of the show. Notice of any changes will be posted at the show or upon request.
16. **Dogs:** No dogs are allowed in the show arena. NO EXCEPTIONS! All dogs must be on a leash when on the grounds.
17. **Mechanical Training Devices:** No personal mechanical training devices allowed. Mechanical cow will be available at the practice pen.
18. **Awards:**
Open, Non Pro, Amateur Classes: Trophy buckles to Champion and Reserve in all classes and awards to all aged event finalists.
Division Classes: Awards to Gelding, 100,000 Limit and 10K Ltd horse division champions.
19. **Event Cancellation.** Ft. Klamath Ranch Cuttings reserves the right to cancel said event or any classes within said event, without notice any time prior to the contest, without liability to the ranch or its officers. In such event, fees pertaining to that class or the event, as the case may be, will be refunded. Ft Klamath Ranch Cuttings reserves the right to cancel this event or portion of this event any time prior to the contest without liability to Ft Klamath Ranches.
