## **NCHA Cutting Edge News Premieres**

The National Cutting Horse Association, in conjunction with Tom Holt, the leading announcer of cutting horse events, has launched a free internet radio program called Cutting Edge News. The show features recaps of the action twice a day from 17 major cutting horse events across the United States.
