Yesterday's fourth set of cattle represented the highs and the lows of the sport.

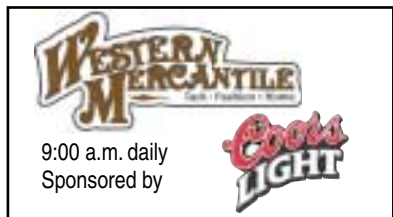
Some Kinda Sweety and Shannon Hall opened the set with a 219.5-point performance that topped the first go-round of Open Derby competition.

But late in the set, NCHA Futurity winner and Super Stakes co-champion High Brow CD, ridden by Austin Shepard, was taken out of contention for the

NCHA Triple Crown by his second cow.

The disappointment was palpable, as High Brow CD walked out before his time had expired. In spite of the loss, spectators still glimpsed the brilliance that brought him to the event as the undefeated champion of four major events. With earnings of \$450,000 (including incentives), he is the leading active performer

sired by High Brow Cat and the top contender for NCHA Horse of the Year.

Some Kinda Sweety, by Sweet Lil Pepto, bred by Meredith McCullar's 4M Ranches, is owned by McCullar's son, Clay. Hall also rode her half-sister, Some Kinda Twister, by Freckles Fancy Twist, to score 216 points on Saturday. Fernturity, another half-sibling by Dual Rey, will be shown later this week in Non-Pro competition.

"They're like my kids; they're all totally different," said Hall of the siblings. "But they're all really good horses. It's neat for one mare to have three in one year that are good.

"(Some Kinda Sweety) was great for me at the Futurity, but she has had some lameness issues and we haven't gotten to work or show her much," added Hall, who rode the mare to place sixth in the NCHA Futurity. "She's really starting to feel like she did back in December."

Clay McCullar also showed Some Kinda Sweety to place third in the Non-Pro division of the Breeders Invitational, where Hall was an Open finalist on the mare, as well.

Some Kinda Memories, dam of Some Kinda Sweety, Some Kinda Twister, and Fernturity, won the 1997 NCHA Futurity under Mike Mowery for Carl and Laura Shrontz.

Hall passed the \$3 million earning's mark last week, when he won the NCHA Classic Challenge on Royal Red Pepto, also bred and owned by Clay McCullar.

Rey Down Sally and Short Scootin

Gary Gonsalves and Matt Gaines each scored 218.5 yesterday on Rey Down Sally and Short Scootin, respectively.

Rey Down Sally, by Dual Rey, is owned by Iron Rose Ranch, Carbondale, CO, and was shown by Gonsalves to place third in the NCHA Futurity and as champion of the Breeders Invitational. She has won over \$250,000.

Short Scootin is owned by his breeders, Don and Debbie Jarma, Prosper, TX. The gelded son of Smart Lil Scoot was trained by Wayne Robinson, who showed him as a Semi-Finalist at the NCHA Futurity, and placed sixth with him in the Tunica Futurity and the Bonanza.

Gaines, who won the 2001 NCHA Derby on Nu I Wood and is cutting's #2 all-time open rider in terms of money won (\$4.9 million), has had Short Scootin for a little more than a month.

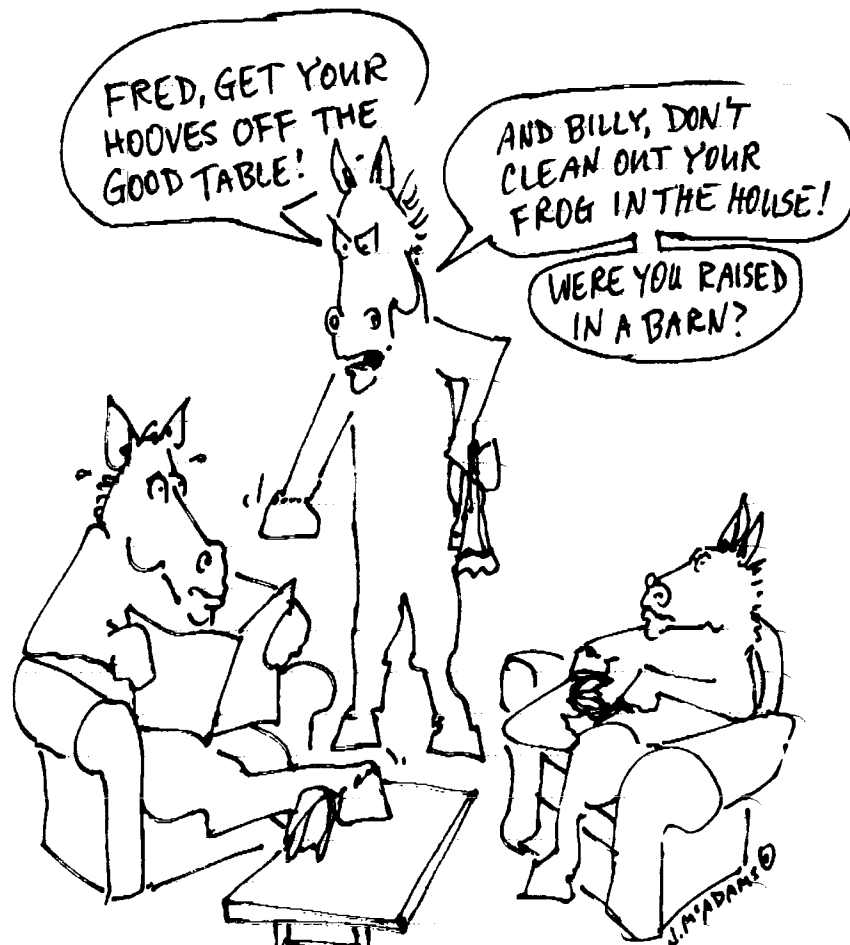
"He's a cool horse," said Gaines, who drew last in the fourth set. "The second cow I cut got a little tough, but she was holdable. I was real proud of him.

"It's always hard when a horse changes programs," added Gaines. "Today was a big confidence builder for him and for me, too. He's a fun little horse and I look forward to showing him more."

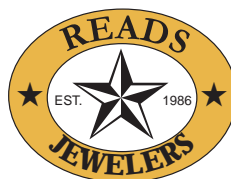

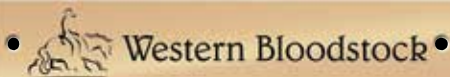
