NYCHA GUIDELINES for Youth Behavior

During the December 2002 NYCHA meeting, a set of behavior guidelines was approved for youth participating in NCHA shows and NYCHA activities. These guidelines are a reminder that NYCHA activities should be a positive environment for all participants and that youth must abide by all NCHA rules as well as city, state or federal laws. These are the guidelines that were approved.

A goal of the National Youth Cutting Horse Association is to encourage moral character, sportsmanship and clean living among all its members. In order to assure that NYCHA activities provide positive environments for all individuals to learn and grow, NYCHA participants agree to abide by these expectations of behavior.

- Show respect, courtesy and consideration to everyone.
- Refrain from the use of vulgar or abusive language.
- Dress appropriately for each event.
- Participate in events fairly by following the rules, not taking advantage of others, and not asking for special exceptions.

Any infraction of the following guidelines, in connection with NYCHA activities, will result in disciplinary action being taken.

- Possession or use of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs is prohibited.
- Possession of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs by a minor is punishable by law.
- Participants will show respect for the property and facilities used during the event and will assume financial responsibility for any damages they cause.
- Any unsportsmanlike conduct before, during, or after any NYCHA event is prohibited.

Those who are unable to conduct themselves according to these guidelines may expect:

- To accept the consequences of their actions and to be reported to the NCHA Executive Director for further disciplinary action which may include suspension from further participation at NCHA shows or forfeiture of awards or points earned.
- To forfeit any leadership positions such as an area director or national officer or any position which might require the individual to represent NYCHA at any regional or national events.
